Overview

The ATHE Level 7 Extended Diploma in Computing Technologies is a 120-credit Ofqual regulated qualification. It provides the core knowledge, understanding, and skills to support learners planning to further their studies and careers in the field of computing technologies. The qualification has been developed in collaboration with subject experts, colleges, higher education institutions, and businesses to ensure the qualification meets their needs. The different pathways allow learners to study a more general (non-specified) program or specialise in particular fields of study as listed below. All pathways have the same credit value.

Entry Requirements

Candidates must hold/meet one or more of the criteria on the list below:

- This course is designed for learners aged 21 and above.
- learners may be working in the field of computing technologies, have participated in the training, and be experienced practitioners.
- graduated in a computing and/or information technology qualification at Level 6.
- a first degree in Computing and/or Information Technology or related subjects and or other equivalent international qualifications.
- IELTS 5.5 or equivalent qualification is preferred if English is not your native language.

Assessment and Verification

All units within this qualification are internally assessed via assignments and externally verified by awarding organisation. There are no examinations in this course.

Course Material

Course materials, including presentations, hand-outs, assignment briefs and e-books are made available to enrolled learners. In addition to this, the learners will also receive the course handbook and tutorials via emails, in order to support the learning.

Online Learning

The learner sets their own pace for their learning and the courses are offered on an academic – year basis. Although our tutors encourage the learners to make progress monthly, this approach is flexible.
